

Summit Overview:

The Greater Phoenix Chamber Foundation is hosting its inaugural Workforce Summit on March 13, 2019. The Summit will provide businesses tools to support their talent development and attraction strategies. Creating robust talent pipelines are essential to business growth and require partnerships between employers, education and training providers, and government. The Workforce Summit will highlight effective partnerships that support business growth through enhanced talent pipelines. The summit will also showcase effective career awareness strategies, industry-led apprenticeships, strategies to recruit diverse candidates, and methods to better engage with education providers to enhance the supply of talent needed to grow your business.

Breakout Session Overview:

Each breakout will cover a Workforce Development strategy currently being implemented in the Greater Phoenix region. Each session is required to have a panel of 2–3 employers who can validate the ROI of the program being presented.

Length and Structure:

Each breakout will be one hour in length and should be structured in the following order:

- 15-minute overview of the workforce program
- 30-minute panel discussion with 2–3 employers currently utilizing the program
- 15-minute Q&A for the audience

- Demonstrate how innovative partnerships are reshaping workforce development in Greater Phoenix
- Share tools to diversify and strengthen the talent pipelines of various industry sectors
- Learn how local industries are using collaborative efforts to influence growth outcomes Provide employers with strategies they can use to grow their talent pipeline
- Gain a clearer understanding of the state of Greater Phoenix's workforce system, progress, and successes
